## Rules: The competition will be covered by CPSA rules

### Team Entries:

Provinces may enter as many Masonic shooters as they wish and every entrant's score will be registered. The Team Winners in the Competition will be the 3 highest scores posted for a given Province.

### Classes of Entry:

**Masonic** - All shooters must be subscribing members of a Craft Lodge or RA Chapter.

**Guests** - Guests should be personal friends or family members of shooters entered in the Competition. Guest Teams may or may not include Masons as members and must be entered in advance

Ladies - Ladies should be family members or friends of Masons taking part.

Juniors - Juniors must be sons or daughters of Masons and under 18 years of age.

**Cartridges** - Must be no more than 1oz (28 Grams) load shot sizes 6 – 9. No Steel.

N.B. Failure to comply with this regulation will lead to disqualification. Cartridges will be on sale. You will require a SGC to purchase.

**Protection** - Ear and Eye protection must be worn. A hat/cap must be worn.

**Time of shoot** - The first round will commence at 9.15am, entries will not be accepted after 2.00pm.

The prize giving ceremony will commence at 4.00pm.

Decisions of the organising committee will be final.
